GRANT MAKING POLICY

Ilsington Parish Council recognises the importance of supporting groups, organisations and charities that benefit the local community, and that making grants is a valuable method of support.

A total figure available for grant aid is agreed by the Council as part of their budget for each financial year.

Requests for grant aid must satisfy the following conditions:-

- Grants will be made to non-political, non-profit making groups, organisations, nonstatutory educational establishments or registered charities.
- Applications must be from a local or national organisation or group which serves the needs of the parish.
- > Only applications submitted to the clerk via post or email and using the Grant Application Form will be considered by the Council.
- > Details of how the grant will be used will be required from each applicant.
- Audited or examined accounts may be requested to support the application.
- The Council require a representative from your organisation to attend a meeting to present the application.
- ➤ Only applications that are eligible to receive Council grants under the statuary powers given to Parish Council can be considered; grant applications will be presented to a full council meeting as soon as is practicable after they have been received.
