 - b) 25/00925/TPO **Location:** ILSINGTON 7 Monro Mead, Liverton **Proposal:** Single oak tree (labelled T1 on sketch plan), to be crown raised and the lower crown reduced to clear number 40 by minimum 3m. Some lower limbs removed to stem where no appropriate pruning points are available further out on each branch.

- 25/00424/TPO Proposal: T2 Oak Fell and treat stump with eco-plugs at ILSINGTON 29 Benedicts Road Liverton
- 25/00505/CLDP Proposal: Certificate of Lawfulness for proposed conversion of part of double garage to art studio including installation of french doors and roof lights to side elevation at ILSINGTON - 3 Otter Court, Ingsdon
- 25/0035 2nr Ash 7 stems to be felled, including a multi-stemmed clump at The Dougalry Green Lane, Ilsington, TQ13 9RB
- 25/0025 T1 oak reduce the northern stem overhanging the field area by up to approx. 2m, with maximum diameter pruning cuts of 5cm
 T2 beech, leans to north reduce the overhanging canopy by up to approx. 2m, maximum diameter pruning cuts of 5cm
 T3 beech reduce the canopy arising from the overhanging northern limb by up to 2.5m, maximum diameter pruning cuts of 5cm at Out Along Green Lane, Ilsington, Newton Abbot, TQ13 9RB
